DISTRIBUTION OF ASHES

For the distribution of ashes on Ash Wednesday, the priests will use the ancient practice of sprinkling dry ashes over the heads of recipients while making the Sign of the Cross. This practice of sprinkling ashes, while not typically used in the U.S., is common in some European countries.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE FOR LENT

Good Friday is a day of Fasting and Abstinence. All parishioners 18-60 years of age are required to fast and abstain from meat unless prevented by ill health, pregnancy, or nursing. Additionally, all Fridays in Lent are days of Abstinence.

Human beings are made for worship and, since each of us is comprised of both a body and a soul, we use our bodies in worship. We stand at attention honoring the Great King, our Lord Jesus Christ who presides at every Liturgy by means of the Priest who stands literally in the person of Christ the Head. We sit so as to better receive the Word of God, as the voice of the Bridegroom, our Lord Jesus Christ, speaks to us His Bride. We kneel in adoration of the God of the Universe, Our Lord Jesus Christ, who comes down to meet us under the appearance of simple bread and wine. Something on the inside is working on the outside. With our hearts aflame with Divine Love, we come to worship our God who fills our lives with meaning, purpose, and joy. This is truly what active participation looks like in the liturgy.

- Do I bow my head during the Creed and when the names of the Persons of the Trinity are said together, along with when the name of Jesus or Mary is mentioned?

- What is one way this week that I can more actively participate in the Sacred Liturgy?

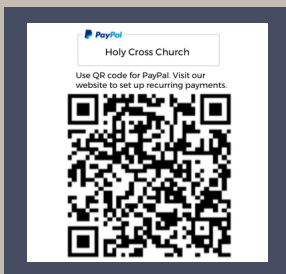
