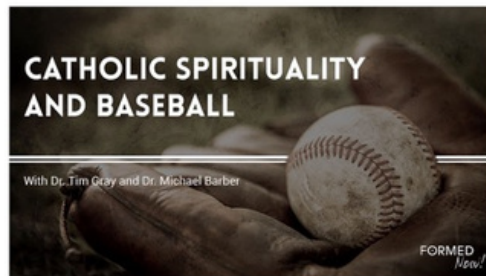
#### JOHN PAUL II IN AMERICA: UNITING A CONTINENT

#### FORMED NOW! CATHOLIC SPIRITUALITY AND BASEBALL

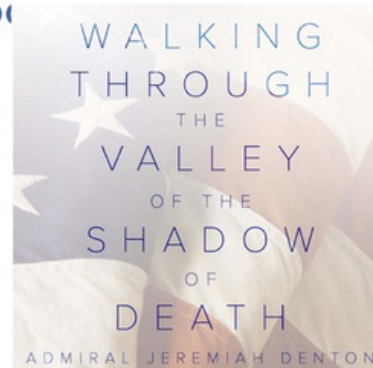
