

#### **NEW PASTOR NAMED!**

Father Mike Tran has been appointed Pastor of Holy Cross Catholic Church for a six-year term, effective July 1, 2021. Father Mike was born in Vietnam in 1974, coming to the United States at the young age of seven. He graduated from Morgan City High School and then entered the seminary. He has a been a priest for the Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux since his ordination on August 10, 2002. He has most recently served as Pastor of Annunziata Catholic Church in Houma.

# The Mass: Liturgy of the Word I

Our meditations on the Mass continue with immersing ourselves into the Liturgy of the Word. We are invited by God into a presentation of his wonderful works on our behalf. The word of God is how we learn of how utterly dependant we are on him, and how deeply his love for us flows, spanning the centuries and millennia of our earthly lives. The culmination of such a love exists in the Word made Flesh, Christ Jesus, who died and rose to smash the chains of sin and eternal death, and to open the gates of heaven to his beloved Bride. We hear then not a dead word, but the plan of salvation from its very genesis. We see, weaving through the tapestry of the Scriptures, hints and glimmers of he who is to come, and glimpses of the heavenly realities toward which we move as Christians, The Magisterium, in her wisdom, shows such connections with her reading choices: the Old Testament reading, showing forth the necessity of the Old Covenant with Israel, is always paired with a Gospel reading that particularly emphasizes how the Old Covenant is fulfilled and transformed by Christ in the New Covenant (with rare exception). The Epistle stands as instruction for the Church as she navigates this world and strives for heaven. And every word of it, proclaimed aloud, gives us the opportunity to be immersed in Christ who is the Word of God. The Church proclaims Christ in every way, that the Word might become flesh time and again during our celebration of these mysteries.

#### REFLECTION

- Where is my mind and my heart during the readings? Do I follow along, either reading or listening attentively?
- Do I read the Sunday readings before I go to Mass? This week, try to read the Sunday readings early, and prepare your mind to focus on them during Mass. What do you hear?
- What revelations of Christ do you pick up on from the Old Testament to the New?
