PENTECOST SUNDAY

READING 1

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language. They were astounded, and in amazement they asked, "Are not all these people who are speaking Galileans? Then how does each of us hear them in his native language? We are Parthians, Medes, and Elamites, inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya near Cyrene, as well as travelers from Rome, both Jews and converts to Judaism, Cretans and Arabs, yet we hear them speaking in our own tongues of the mighty acts of God."

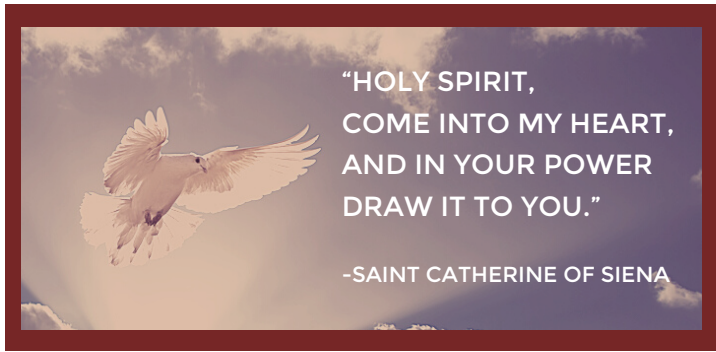
SEQUENCE

| The Spirit and the Bride Say Come

Many liturgical prayers end in a way which is purposefully repetitive: “...through our Lord, Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.”

The Holy Spirit’s power and guidance teaches us to know Christ and his Gospel (John 14:25-26) on earth today. It is through the power of the Holy Spirit that we enter into the Liturgy. Thus the words of Revelation speak clearly to us:

“The Spirit and the Bride say, ‘Come.’”

(Rev. 22:17). For it is the Bride and the Holy Spirit which call us into the heavenly liturgy, which we are privileged to participate in now, on earth! And so we answer the call, allowing ourselves to be swept up in the Spirit who brings us to our Bridegroom, who in turn lifts us up to the Father and helps us enter into that Trinitarian relationship for all eternity.

- How can I purposefully ask God the Holy Spirit to enter more fully into my heart, into my prayer?
- What particular gifts of the Holy Spirit should I ask him to enliven in me?

- Apparition: Our Lady asked for sinners to do penance, a chapel of Eucharistic adoration to be built so Jesus could convert sinners, and a house for priests for administering sacraments to sinners.
- Also known as: Our Lady of Happy Meetings



Our Lady of Lourdes

- February - July 1858
- Lourdes, France
- Feast: February 11
- Appeared to: Bernadette, 14
- Apparition: Our Lady asked for prayers and penitence for the conversion of sinners. She asked Bernadette to dig in the ground revealing a spring. Millions visit Lourdes yearly. Many claim complete healing from the water.
- Bernadette was canonized in 1933.

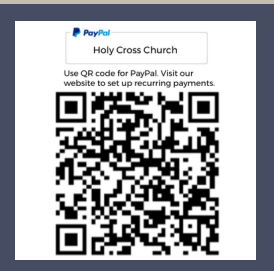


