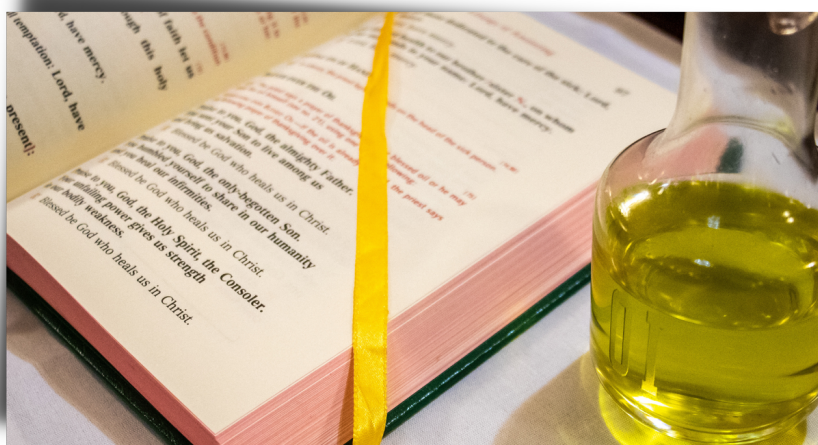


## Sacramentality: Objects Part II: Oils

Last time, we spoke of fire and light. Now we speak of a different element: oil. We use three particularly blessed oils in many of our liturgical practices, namely the Oil of the Infirm, the Oil of Catechumens, and the Sacred Chrism. Why oil? Oil is a rich substance, used for so many purposes outside of the faith for so many years; it is made by pressing and grinding olives until the oil is released. It is safe to say, the process is lengthy and not very gentle. There is hard work put into creating this smooth, soothing oil, just as there is hard, pressing work put into our becoming Christians. Thus oil, as something so beautifully rich and useful, naturally is a choice for liturgical practices as well: anointing on the head is and always has been a sign of the Holy Spirit descending (God asking Moses to anoint the priests to make them holy; Samuel anointing David and the Spirit of God rushing upon him); anointing of the chest acts as an armour against the powers of darkness. The Oil of the Infirm strengthens us to bear suffering as Christ did, and for the final journey into death and eternal life. The Oil of the Catechumens acts as a breastplate during the Rite of Exorcism, shielding the Catechumens from Satan. The Sacred Chrism, with its sweet perfume of balsam, is consecrated particularly, so that by its use, we may call down the Holy Spirit on those being baptized, those being confirmed, or those being ordained.

**Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity! It is like the precious oil upon the head, running down upon the beard, upon the beard of Aaron, running down on the collar of his robes! It is like the dew of Hermon, which falls on the mountains of Zion! For there the Lord has commanded the blessing, life for evermore.**
